Who We Are

Rainbow Camp is a camp for children who are infected or affected with the HIV/AIDS virus. The Camp provides a secure week-long environment at the Claggett Center for these children where they could be children without encumbering the burden of living with or caring for family members infected with HIV/AIDS, as well as possible having the virus themselves. Campers are referred from HIV/AIDS service providers in Maryland. Most campers come from inner-city Baltimore; however, the camp is open

to all children. Repeat campers' parents/guardians also contact us for camp applications.

At Rainbow Camp, campers make new friends. They learn to work as a team. There is plenty of good, healthy food. The staff is made up of dedicated and skilled volunteers. Counselors are 18 years of age and older. Junior counselors must be 16 years of age. Counselors must attend the diocesan Safeguarding God's Children training.
