### Who We Are

The Sutton Scholars Program offers a well-defined curriculum aligned with educational best practices. The program introduces global interaction and understanding and provides athletic exercise. Its primary focus is on developing soft and life skills to undergird academic high school course work.



The four-week program operates Monday-Friday, 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. It serves nutritious meals daily and offers pre- and

post-assessment of skills and attitudes, requires parent/caregiver involvement, includes trained teachers and mentors, and follows the scholars from 9th through 12th grades.

The program is designed to serve as a model for the implementation of programs like this in other geographic areas throughout the Episcopal Diocese of Maryland and beyond.

The Sutton Scholars Program teaches children to become confident, competent individuals by providing them with the essential gift of soft and life skills. These skills will help children become better students and adults.
